

Fedora Asahi SIG

The Special Interest Group (SIG) packages and maintains the software used to support Apple Silicon platforms on Fedora Linux.

We develop and maintain variants of Fedora media for Apple Silicon platforms.

FEDORA ASAHI REMIX

Fedora Asahi Remix

This Remix is a special derivative of Fedora Linux that is optimized around Apple Silicon hardware

Core changes:

- Custom kernel derived from the Fedora kernel with Asahi patches
 Custom mesa derived from the Fedora
- Custom mesa derived from the Fedora packaging with Asahi patches
 Custom u-boot derived from the Fedora
- Custom u-boot derived from the Fedora packaging with Asahi patches
- Fedora Asahi Remix branding

The Remix comes in KDE, GNOME, Server, and Minimal flavors.




FEDORA ASAHI REMIX KDE

The flagship experience

This variant is a partnership of the Fedora Asahi SIG and the Fedora KDE SIG, along with upstream Asahi Linux contributors.

- Includes a curated collection of KDE software to demonstrate the quality of the ecosystem
- Aims to provide quality KDE Plasma Desktop experience largely based on upstream defaults
 - Minor branding and usability tweaks
 - Mozilla Firefox as the browser
 - FirewallD and SELinux for security

FEDORA ASAHI REMIX GNOME

A polished experience

This variant is a derivative of Fedora Workstation for Apple Silicon platforms.

- Includes a mostly vanilla GNOME experience
 - Minor branding and usability tweaks
 - Mozilla Firefox as the browser
 - FirewallD and SELinux for security

FEDORA ASAHI REMIX SERVER AND MINIMAL

Mac servers and clouds...

These variants are intended to be used for headless and automated provisioning environments.

- The Server variant provides the software and configuration similar to Fedora Server Edition
- The Minimal variant provides a barebones Fedora environment to be used with automation for custom setups.

BUTTERING UP FEDORA

Switching to Btrfs...

One of the more "interesting" changes Fedora Linux has implemented, but required a lot of testing across the board:

- Every desktop variant across all supported architectures
 - o ARM was extremely difficult
 - Many cheap computers burned out for the cause...

APPLE SILICON LINUX PORT ANNOUNCED

Hector Martin starts...

Hector announces the effort to port Linux to Apple Silicon with a Patreon project to raise \$4,000 to get started on November 30, 2020.

The goal is met overnight.

The Asahi Linux project is announced on Christmas Day 2020.

CULTIVATING ASAHI / ARM BUTTER BURNOUT

Two parallel tracks...

Over the course of 2021, the Asahi Linux project successfully implements basic platform bringup and upstreams it to Linux and U-Boot.

Meanwhile, Fedora Btrfs feature development struggles on ARM due to difficulties reliably developing and testing.

(Also, Freenode imploded during this time, which kind of sucked... But hey, Fedora Chat exists now!)

ASAHI ARCH ALPHA / FEDORA ASAHI BEGINS

Two parallel tracks...

By early 2022, the Asahi Arch Alpha was released for M1 and M1 Pro/Max systems.

The Fedora Asahi project is created in 2021, but initial porting efforts begin in 2022 due to difficulties acquiring hardware.

The first Asahi Fedora images are made in early September 2022 using the KIWI image build tool.





ASAHI FEDORA TO FEDORA ASAHI


Properly Fedora branded!

The Asahi SIG requested approval to use Fedora branding for the Remix, including permission to use the Fedora logos. This was granted and thus the Asahi Fedora Remix became the Fedora Asahi Remix.

FEDORA ASAHI CURRENT STATUS

Asahi-relevant Fedora work


Fedora KDE uses Wayland from beginning to end

- F34 Change to use Plasma Wayland
- <u>F35 Change to sdl12-compat for SDL1</u> applications
- F38 Change to use SDDM Wayland

Fedora uses PipeWire

- F34 Change to use PipeWire
- <u>F35 Change to use WirePlumber with</u> <u>PipeWire</u>

Fixes to various packages to support ARM systems running with 16K page sizes (e.g. Chromium, WebKitGTK, QtWebEngine, etc.)

FEDORA ASAHI CURRENT STATUS

Broad support for ARM Macs

Today, Fedora Asahi Remix has decent coverage of Apple Silicon hardware:

- Device support: All M1+ machines, M2 2022 laptops
- Firmware support: All on v13.5
- Hardware accelerated graphics by default

A few things are **not** supported (yet!)

- Speaker support
- Camera support
- DP Alt Mode, Thunderbolt DisplayPort, or HDMI support on laptops




FEDORA ASAHI RELEASE

Asahi Linux and Fedora Asahi SIG are proud to reveal that the **Fedora** Asahi Remix is the new flagship distribution, developed in partnership between Asahi Linux and the Fedora Project.

The tentative "official" release planned for end of August 2023.


