WAYLAND BY DEFAULT

Leaping into the future!

KDE Plasma now runs with Plasma Wayland by default, rather than the legacy XII session. This gives us a smoother graphics pipeline with greater performance. Fedora is the first distribution to make the switch for KDE Plasma.


